WHAT IS MULTIMODAL WRITING?

Multimodal writing allows students to explore different forms of writing other than the traditional essay. You can include various genres, styles, and modes. For this project, you will tap into your knowledge of Beowulf and your imagination to produce a project that demonstrates a sophisticated understanding of the text.

DIRECTIONS

Choose 1 “mode” from the following list. Unless noted, each document should be at least 270 words (include word count). When possible, type your project.

1. Poetry (16 lines min.)
2. Journal/Diary Entry from the perspective of a character
3. Personal Letter from a character in Beowulf
4. Advice Column
5. Newspaper Article
6. Obituary or Eulogy
7. Short Story (Flash Fiction)
8. Memoir (first person autobiography)
9. Comic Strip (color, computer-generated or hand-drawn, 9 cells min.)
10. Chart or Map (full color, computer-generated or hand-drawn)
11. Soundtrack (playlist of 8 songs with a 2-3 sentence blurb about each song choice)
12. Pinterest Board (20 pins with original 1-sentence caption for each)
